Answer: Piazza San Marco

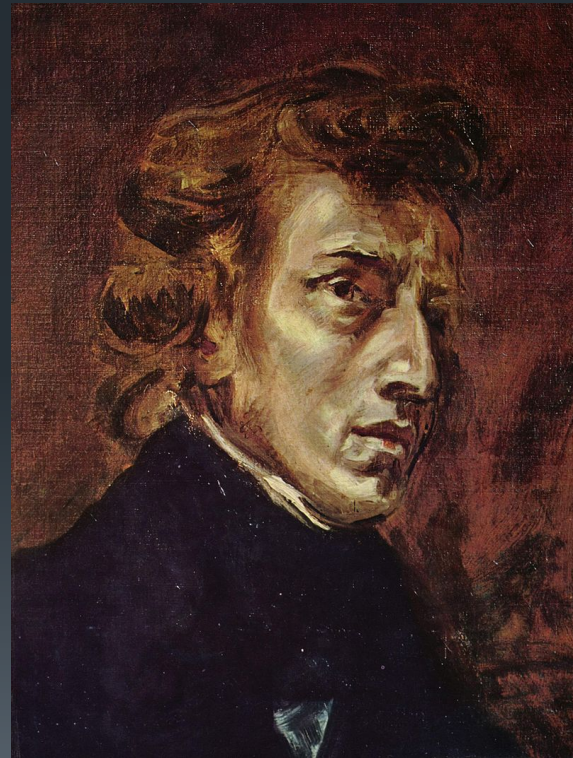


Who composed this piece of music?

- His love life and his early death have made him a leading symbol of the Romantic era

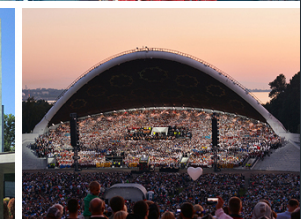
Answer: Chopin
