there is a pool.*

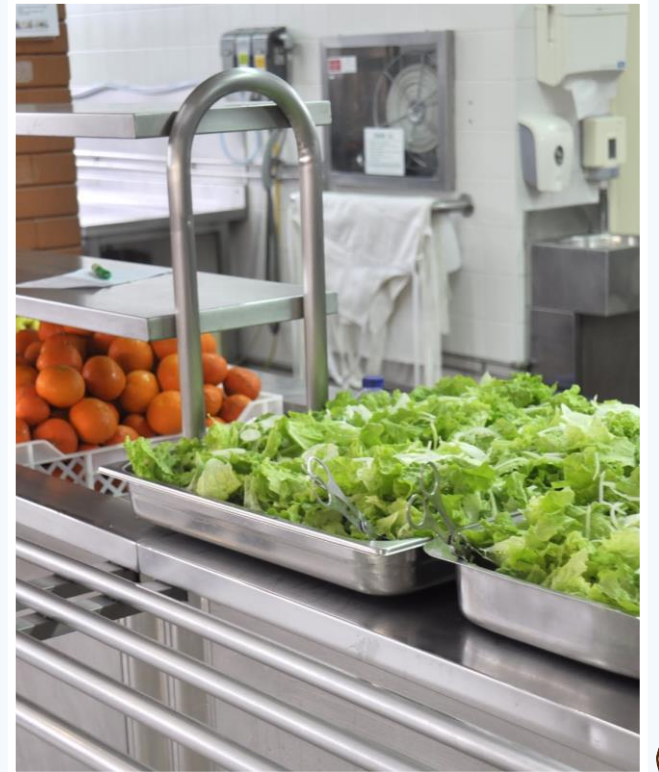
- When we were at school we did workshops and attended lessons with the Portuguese students.

We were really embarrassed... but we managed and it was good for practising English.



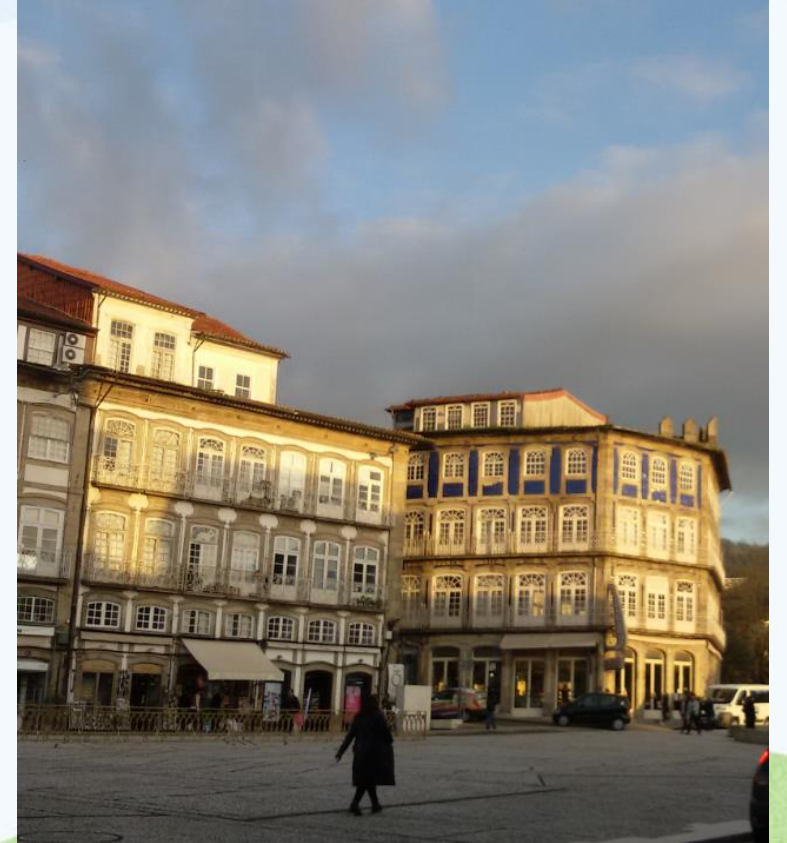

We also had time to visit some monuments and some other cities nearby and to see a lot of interesting things.



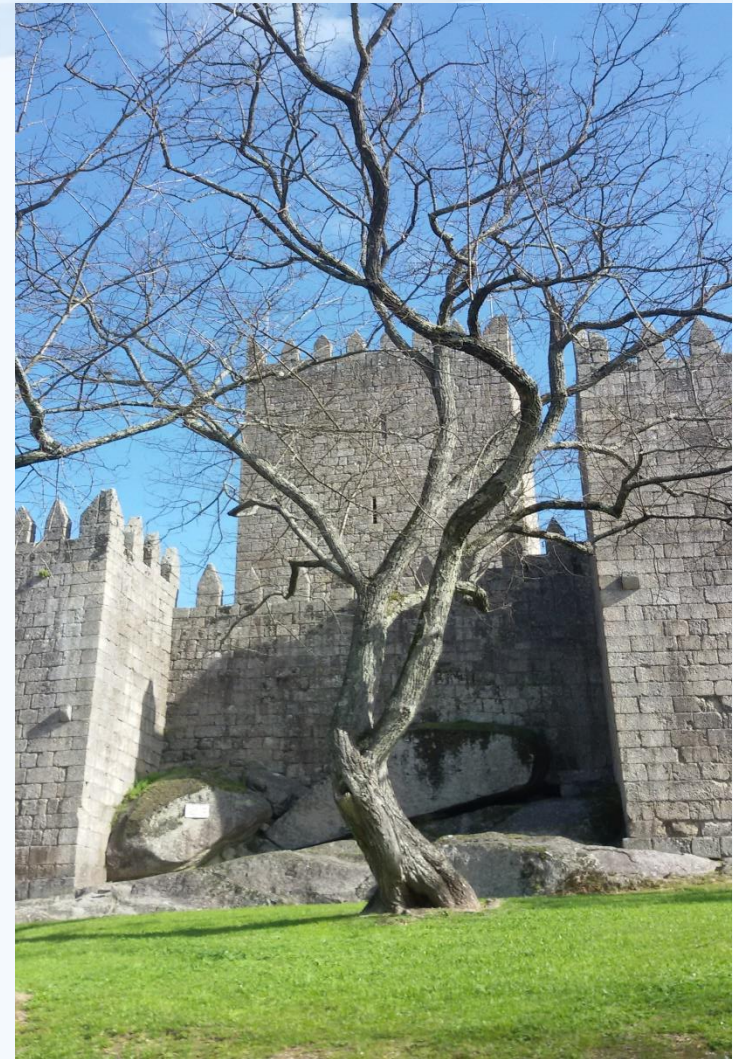


- Alice: My favourite food was the typical Portuguese pastries, “Pastéis de nata”, pastries filled with a very tasty and sweet cream.
