
Our school is in Via Pisa, near the centre of Borbiago, a district of Mira (Venice).

Adele Zara the memorial day

January 27th is an international day of commemoration in memory of the holocaust victims. On the 27th of January of (1945) the Soviet army released the prisoners of the largest Nazi death camp in Auschwitz (Poland).

Since 2005 in Italy every 27th of January, holocaust victims have been commemorated.

During the Shoah the Jews were banished to ghettoes and were taken to the terrible concentration camps, where they became slaves without food or water. Many of them died of sickness and starvation but many more were murdered, because they were sent into the gas chambers.

Adele Zara was a partisan, she was born in Oriago and during the Second World War she was able to save the Levis, a Jewish family, hiding them in her house, for this reason our institute is called Adele Zara in her memory.

The school history

Our school was designed in the early 1970s by a local and rather notorious architect Gianpaolo Mar. The exterior looks like the structure of an overturned ship with characteristics that can be found in the roofs of some Venetian churches. From an architectural point of view it represents a concrete example of structure "EXPOSED".

The school structure

The floor plan has a rectangular shape and it has two floors; a cental corridor leads to the ground floor classrooms. On the second floor you have the same structure for the different laboratories. The services and the gymnasium have been restored recently.
